Returning from hieroglyphic Luwian to the Hittite language of the cuneiform tablets of the Hittite kingdom, we have to stress the importance of Hittite studies for historical linguistics Since the oldest Hittite tablets date from ca 1600 BC they are by far the oldest written texts in any IE language
